San Angelo Soccer Association Safety Protocols

Each team is responsible to monitor their own players and spectators

To assure these protocols are followed. If a team is incompliant with the protocols,
a Board Member will ask the ref to stop the game until all are compliant.

- 1. Everyone 10 years and older who enters the soccer complex MUST wear a mask. Once you have arrived at your field and can social distance, you may remove your mask at your discretion. A mask is required anytime you are walking through the complex.
- 2. Anyone who has a fever or is showing other signs of illness should not come to the soccer complex.
- 3. If any person associated with your team has a positive test for Covid-19, the Coach/Manager should report this to SASA immediately.
- 4. The team and all of their parents/spectators will sit on the same side of the field. Opponents with all of their parents/spectators will sit on the opposite sidelines. Please review the field map and schedule to determine which side your team will be using. Home team will use the South/West side and Away team will use the North/East side.
- 5. **ARRIVAL AT THE GAME Teams** should arrive at the field no earlier than 30 minutes prior to game time. All should leave the field immediately after the game is complete. This will allow safe arrival for the next group. (NO AFTER GAME DISCUSSIONS AT THE FIELDS. NO LOITERING)
- 6. No hand shaking or high fives any time before, during or after the game. Only 1 player/captain will participate in any coin toss with the Referee.
- 7. Bathrooms will be available and will be disinfected as often as possible. Please be patient with the cleaning staff as they are cleaning to keep you safe.
- 8. WHEN APPROACHING A LEAGUE OFFICIAL A MASK MUST BE WORN AND A DISTANCE KEPT.

NOTE: NO MASKS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE SOCCER COMPLEX. EACH PERSON SHOULD WEAR A MASK OR HAVE ONE AVAILABLE TO THEM.
